Autistic people and their families have told us how hard using public transport can be. You've already helped by pledging to make a small change to help reduce the overload for autistic people. Now we need the people in charge of public transport to play their part.

Unexpected changes when taking public transport can be overwhelming for autistic people. For some, the fear of unexpected changes could mean not even leaving the house. Autistic people and their families put so much effort into planning their journeys only for overwhelming noise, crowds and a lack of information to undo it all.

**We want to change that.**

Transport providers, along with the Department for Transport, have the power to make public transport more autism friendly, benefiting the 3 million autistic people and their families across the UK.

We want to put pressure on transport providers to make necessary changes – from better training for their staff to reducing excess noise and lighting – but we can only do that with your help.

By signing our open letter, you will be helping us to make the case to the Government and to transport providers as to why autism friendly transport is so necessary and so important to so many.
